

STANDARD POSSESSION ORDER PURSUANT TO THE TEXAS FAMILY CODE

1. Standard Possession Order

The Court finds that the following provisions of this Standard Possession Order are intended to and do comply with the requirements of Texas Family Code sections 153.311 through 153.317. IT IS ORDERED that each conservator shall comply with all terms and conditions of this Standard Possession Order. IT IS ORDERED that this Standard Possession Order is effective immediately and applies to all periods of possession occurring on and after the date the Court signs this Standard Possession Order. IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED:

(a) Definitions

1. In this Standard Possession Order "school" means the primary or secondary school in which the child is enrolled or, if the child is not enrolled in a primary or secondary school, the public school district in which the child primarily resides.

2. In this Standard Possession Order "child" includes each child, whether one or more, who is a subject of this suit while that child is under the age of eighteen years and not otherwise emancipated.

(b) Mutual Agreement or Specified Terms for Possession

IT IS ORDERED that the conservators shall have possession of the child at times mutually agreed to in advance by the parties, and, in the absence of mutual agreement, it is ORDERED that the conservators shall have possession of the child under the specified terms set out in this Standard Possession Order.

(c) [Parents/Conservators] Who Reside 100 Miles or Less Apart

Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this Standard Possession Order, when [name] resides 100 miles or less from the primary residence of the child, [name] shall have the right to possession of the child as follows:

1. Weekends - On weekends, beginning at [time], on the first, third, and fifth Friday of each month and ending at [time].

2. Weekend Possession Extended by a Holiday - Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this Standard Possession Order, if a weekend period of possession by [name] begins on a Friday that is a school holiday during the regular school term or a federal, state, or local holiday during the summer months when school is not in session, or if the period ends on or is immediately followed by a Monday that is such a holiday, that weekend period of possession shall begin at [time] on the Thursday immediately preceding the Friday holiday or school holiday or end [time], as applicable.

3. Thursdays - On Thursday of each week during the regular

school term, beginning at [time] and ending at [time].

4. Spring Break in Even-Numbered Years - In even-numbered years, beginning at [time] on the day the child is dismissed from school for the school's spring vacation and ending at [time] school resumes after that vacation.

5. Extended Summer Possession by [name] -

With Written Notice by April 1 - If [name] gives [name] written notice by April 1 of a year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the child for thirty days beginning no earlier than the day after the child's school is dismissed for the summer vacation and ending no later than seven days before school resumes at the end of the summer vacation in that year, to be exercised in no more than two separate periods of at least seven consecutive days each, as specified in the written notice*, provided that the period or periods of extended summer possession do not interfere with Father's Day Weekend*. These periods of possession shall begin and end at 6:00 p.m.

Without Written Notice by April 1 - If [name] does not give [name] written notice by April 1 of a year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the child for thirty consecutive days in that year beginning at 6:00 p.m. on July 1 and ending at 6:00 p.m. on July 31.

Notwithstanding the weekend and Thursday periods of possession ORDERED for [name], it is explicitly ORDERED that [name] shall have a superior right of possession of the child as follows:

1. Spring Break in Odd-Numbered Years - In odd-numbered years, beginning at [time] on the day the child is dismissed from school for the school's spring vacation and ending at [time] school resumes after that vacation.

2. Summer Weekend Possession by [name] - If [name] gives [name] written notice by April 15 of a year, [name] shall have possession of the child on any one weekend beginning at 6:00 p.m. on Friday and ending at 6:00 p.m. on the following Sunday during any one period of the extended summer possession by [name] in that year, provided that [name] picks up the child from [name] and returns the child to that same place* and that the weekend so designated does not interfere with Father's Day Weekend*.

3. Extended Summer Possession by [name] - If [name] gives [name] written notice by April 15 of a year or gives [name] fourteen days' written notice on or after April 16 of a year, [name] may designate one weekend beginning no earlier than the day after the child's school is dismissed for the summer vacation and ending no later than seven days before school resumes at the end of the summer vacation, during which an otherwise scheduled weekend period of possession by [name] shall not take

place in that year, provided that the weekend so designated does not interfere with [name]'s period or periods of extended summer possession* [or with Father's Day Weekend]*.

(d) [Parents/Conservators] Who Reside More Than 100 Miles Apart

Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this Standard Possession Order, when [name] resides more than 100 miles from the residence of the child, [name] shall have the right to possession of the child as follows:

*[1. Weekends - Unless [name] elects the alternative period of weekend possession described in the next paragraph, [name] shall have the right to possession of the child on weekends, beginning at [time], on the first, third, and fifth Friday of each month and ending at [time]. Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this Standard Possession Order, if such a weekend period of possession by [name] begins on a Friday that is a school holiday during the regular school term or a federal, state, or local holiday during the summer months when school is not in session, or if the period ends on or is immediately followed by a Monday that is such a holiday, that weekend period of possession shall begin at [time] on the Thursday immediately preceding the Friday holiday or school holiday or end [time], as applicable.

Alternate Weekend Possession - In lieu of the weekend possession described in the foregoing paragraph, [name] shall have the right to possession of the child not more than one weekend per month of [name]'s choice beginning at [time] on the day school recesses for the weekend and ending at [time] after the weekend. Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this Standard Possession Order, if such a weekend period of possession by [name] begins on a Friday that is a school holiday during the regular school term or a federal, state, or local holiday during the summer months when school is not in session, or if the period ends on or is immediately followed by a Monday that is such a holiday, that weekend period of possession shall begin at [time] on the Thursday immediately preceding the Friday holiday or school holiday or end [time], as applicable. [name] may elect an option for this alternative period of weekend possession by giving written notice to [name] within ninety days after the parties begin to reside more than 100 miles apart. If [name] makes this election, [name] shall give [name] fourteen days' written or telephonic notice preceding a designated weekend. The weekends chosen shall not conflict with the provisions regarding Christmas, Thanksgiving[,/, and] the child's birthday[Mother's Day/Father's Day Weekend] below.

**[1. Weekends - On weekends, beginning at [time] on the first, third, and fifth Friday of each month, and ending at [time]. Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this Standard Possession Order, if a weekend period of possession by [name] begins on a Friday that is a school holiday during the regular school term or a federal, state, or local holiday during the summer months when school is not in session, or if the period ends on or is

immediately followed by a Monday that is such a holiday, that weekend period of possession shall begin at [time] on the Thursday immediately preceding the Friday holiday or school holiday or end [time], as applicable.

]***[1. Weekend - One weekend per month, of [name]'s choice, beginning at [time] on the day school recesses for the weekend and ending at [time] after the weekend, provided that [name] gives [name] fourteen days' written or telephonic notice preceding a designated weekend. The weekends chosen shall not conflict with the provisions regarding Christmas, Thanksgiving[,/, and] the child's birthday[Mother's Day/Father's Day Weekend] below.

] * 2. Spring Break in All Years - Every year, beginning at [time] on the day the child is dismissed from school for the school's spring vacation and ending at [time] school resumes after that vacation.

3. Extended Summer Possession by [name] -

With Written Notice by April 1 - If [name] gives [name] written notice by April 1 of a year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the child for forty-two days beginning no earlier than the day after the child's school is dismissed for the summer vacation and ending no later than seven days before school resumes at the end of the summer vacation in that year, to be exercised in no more than two separate periods of at least seven consecutive days each, as specified in the written notice*[, provided that the period or periods of extended summer possession do not interfere with Father's Day Weekend]*. These periods of possession shall begin and end at 6:00 p.m.

Without Written Notice by April 1 - If [name] does not give [name] written notice by April 1 of a year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the child for forty-two consecutive days beginning at 6:00 p.m. on June 15 and ending at 6:00 p.m. on July 27 of that year.

Notwithstanding the weekend periods of possession ORDERED for [name], it is explicitly ORDERED that [name] shall have a superior right of possession of the child as follows:

1. Summer Weekend Possession by [name] - If [name] gives [name] written notice by April 15 of a year, [name] shall have possession of the child on any one weekend beginning at 6:00 p.m. on Friday and ending at 6:00 p.m. on the following Sunday during any one period of possession by [name] during [name]'s extended summer possession in that year, provided that if a period of possession by [name] in that year exceeds thirty days, [name] may have possession of the child under the terms of this provision on any two nonconsecutive weekends during that period and provided that [name] picks up the child from [name] and returns the child to that same

place*[and that the weekend so designated does not interfere with Father's Day Weekend]*.

2. Extended Summer Possession by [name] - If [name] gives [name] written notice by April 15 of a year, [name] may designate twenty-one days beginning no earlier than the day after the child's school is dismissed for the summer vacation and ending no later than seven days before school resumes at the end of the summer vacation in that year, to be exercised in no more than two separate periods of at least seven consecutive days each, during which [name] shall not have possession of the child, provided that the period or periods so designated do not interfere with [name]'s period or periods of extended summer possession*[or with Father's Day Weekend]*.

(e) Holidays Unaffected by Distance

Notwithstanding the weekend and Thursday periods of possession of [name], [name] and [name] shall have the right to possession of the child as follows:

1. Christmas Holidays in Even-Numbered Years - In even-numbered years, [name] shall have the right to possession of the child beginning at [time] on the day the child is dismissed from school for the Christmas school vacation and ending at noon on December 26, and [name] shall have the right to possession of the child beginning at noon on December 26 and ending at [time] school resumes after that Christmas school vacation.

2. Christmas Holidays in Odd-Numbered Years - In odd-numbered years, [name] shall have the right to possession of the child beginning at [time] on the day the child is dismissed from school for the Christmas school vacation and ending at noon on December 26, and [name] shall have the right to possession of the child beginning at noon on December 26 and ending at [time] the child's school resumes after that Christmas school vacation.

3. Thanksgiving in Odd-Numbered Years - In odd-numbered years, [name] shall have the right to possession of the child beginning at [time] on the day the child is dismissed from school for the Thanksgiving holiday and ending at [time].

4. Thanksgiving in Even-Numbered Years - In even-numbered years, [name] shall have the right to possession of the child beginning at [time] on the day the child is dismissed from school for the Thanksgiving holiday and ending at [time].

5. Child's Birthday - If a [parent/conservator] is not otherwise entitled under this Standard Possession Order to present possession of [a/the] child on the child's birthday, that [parent/conservator] shall have possession of the child*[and the child's minor siblings]* beginning at 6:00

p.m. and ending at 8:00 p.m. on that day, provided that that [parent/conservator] picks up the child[ren] from the other [parent/conservator]'s residence and returns the child[ren] to that same place.

*[6. Father's Day Weekend - [name] shall have the right to possession of the child each year, beginning at 6:00 p.m. on the Friday preceding Father's Day and ending at 6:00 p.m. on Father's Day, provided that if [name] is not otherwise entitled under this Standard Possession Order to present possession of the child, he shall pick up the child from [name]'s residence and return the child to that same place.

**[7. Mother's Day Weekend - [name] shall have the right to possession of the child each year, beginning at 6:00 p.m. on the Friday preceding Mother's Day and ending at 6:00 p.m. on Mother's Day, provided that if [name] is not otherwise entitled under this Standard Possession Order to present possession of the child, she shall pick up the child from [name]'s residence and return the child to that same place.

](f) Undesignated Periods of Possession

[name] shall have the right of possession of the child at all other times not specifically designated in this Standard Possession Order for [name].

(g) General Terms and Conditions

Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this Standard Possession Order, the terms and conditions of possession of the child that apply regardless of the distance between the residence of a [parent/conservator] and the child are as follows:

1. Surrender of Child by [name] - [name] is ORDERED to surrender the child to [name] at the beginning of each period of [name]'s possession at the residence of [name].

*[If a period of possession by [name] begins at the time the child's school is regularly dismissed, [name] is ORDERED to surrender the child to [name] at the beginning of each such period of possession at the school in which the child is enrolled. If the child is not in school, [name] shall pick up the child at the residence of [name] at _____, and [name] is ORDERED to surrender the child to [name] at the residence of [name] at _____ under these circumstances.

**[2. Surrender of Child by [name] - [name] is ORDERED to surrender the child to [name] at the residence of [name] at the end of each period of possession.

**[2. Return of Child by [name] - [name] is ORDERED to return the child to the residence of [name] at the end of each period of possession.

However, it is ORDERED that, if [name] and [name] live in the same county at the time of rendition of this order, [name]'s county of residence remains the same after rendition of this order, and [name]'s county of residence changes, effective on the date of the change of residence by [name], [name] shall surrender the child to [name] at the residence of [name] at the end of each period of possession.

]**[If a period of possession by [name] ends at the time the child's school resumes, [name] is ORDERED to surrender the child to [name] at the end of each such period of possession at the school in which the child is enrolled or, if the child is not in school, at the residence of [name] at _____.

] * 3. Surrender of Child by [name] - [name] is ORDERED to surrender the child to [name], if the child is in [name]'s possession or subject to [name]'s control, at the beginning of each period of [name]'s exclusive periods of possession, at the place designated in this Standard Possession Order.

4. Return of Child by [name] - [name] is ORDERED to return the child to [name], if [name] is entitled to possession of the child, at the end of each of [name]'s exclusive periods of possession, at the place designated in this Standard Possession Order.

5. Personal Effects - Each conservator is ORDERED to return with the child the personal effects that the child brought at the beginning of the period of possession.

6. Designation of Competent Adult - Each conservator may designate any competent adult to pick up and return the child, as applicable. IT IS ORDERED that a conservator or a designated competent adult be present when the child is picked up or returned.

7. Inability to Exercise Possession - Each conservator is ORDERED to give notice to the person in possession of the child on each occasion that the conservator will be unable to exercise that conservator's right of possession for any specified period.

8. Written Notice - Written notice shall be deemed to have been timely made if received or postmarked before or at the time that notice is due.

*[9. Notice to School and [name] - If [name]'s time of possession of the child ends at the time school resumes and for any reason the child is not or will not be returned to school, [name] shall immediately notify the school and [name] that the child will not be or has not been returned to school.

] *

This concludes the Standard Possession Order.

]**[2. Possession Order

IT IS ORDERED that each party shall comply with all terms and conditions of this Possession Order. IT IS ORDERED that this Possession Order is effective immediately and applies to all periods of possession occurring on and after the date the Court signs this Possession Order. IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED:

(a) Definition

In this order "school" means the primary or secondary school in which a child is enrolled or, if a child is not enrolled in a primary or secondary school, the public school district in which the child primarily resides.

(b) Mutual Agreement or Specified Terms for Possession

IT IS ORDERED that [name] shall have possession of [names] at all times not specifically set aside for [name] and as set out elsewhere in this order. IT IS ORDERED that [name] shall have possession of [names] at all times not specifically set aside for [name] and as set out elsewhere in this order. IT IS ORDERED that each [parent/conservator] shall have possession of the children at any and all times mutually agreed to in advance by the parties and, in the absence of mutual agreement, IT IS ORDERED that each party, beginning immediately on the signing of this order, shall have possession of the children under the specified terms set out in this order. IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED:

(c) Periods of Possession

Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this order, each party shall have the right to possession of the children as follows:

1. Weekends - [name] shall have possession of the children beginning at [time] on the first and third Friday of each month and ending at [time]. [name] shall have possession of the children beginning at [time] on the second and fourth Friday of each month and ending at [time].

*[In each month containing five Fridays, [name] shall have possession of [names] beginning at [time] on the fifth Friday and ending at [time]. In each month containing five Fridays, [name] shall have possession of [names] beginning at [time] on the fifth Friday and ending at [time].

] * 2. Weekend Possession Extended by a School Holiday - Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this order, if a weekend period of possession by a [parent/conservator] begins on a Friday that is a school holiday during the regular school term, that weekend period of possession shall begin at [time] on the Thursday immediately preceding the Friday school holiday.

Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this order, if a weekend

period of possession by a [parent/conservator] is followed by a Monday that is a school holiday during the regular school term, that weekend period of possession shall end at [time].

3. Weekend Possession Extended by a Summer Holiday - Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this order, if a weekend period of possession by a [parent/conservator] begins on a Friday that is a federal, state, or local holiday during the summer months when school is not in session, that weekend period of possession shall begin at 6:00 p.m. on the Thursday immediately preceding the Friday holiday.

Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this order, if a weekend period of possession by a [parent/conservator] ends on or is immediately followed by a Monday that is a federal, state, or local holiday during the summer months when school is not in session, that weekend period of possession shall end at 6:00 p.m. on that Monday holiday.

4. Thursdays - [name] shall have possession of the children on Thursday of each week during the regular school term, beginning at [time] and ending at [time].

5. Wednesdays - [name] shall have possession of the children on Wednesday of each week during the regular school term, beginning at [time] and ending at [time].

Notwithstanding the weekend, Wednesday, and Thursday periods of possession provided above, [name] and [name] shall have the right to possession of the children as follows:

1. First Part of Christmas Holidays - [name] shall have possession of the children in even-numbered years, beginning at [time] on the day the children are dismissed from school for the Christmas school vacation and ending at noon on December 26. [name] shall have possession of the children in odd-numbered years, beginning at [time] on the day the children are dismissed from school for the Christmas school vacation and ending at noon on December 26.

2. Last Part of Christmas Holidays - [name] shall have possession of the children in odd-numbered years, beginning at noon on December 26 and ending at [time] the children's school resumes after that Christmas school vacation. [name] shall have possession of the children in even-numbered years, beginning at noon on December 26 and ending at [time] the children's school resumes after that Christmas school vacation.

3. Thanksgiving - [name] shall have possession of the children in odd-numbered years, beginning at [time] on the day the children are dismissed from school for the Thanksgiving holiday and ending at [time]. [name] shall have possession of the children in even-numbered years, beginning at [time] on the day the children are dismissed from school for the

Thanksgiving holiday and ending at [time].

4. Spring Vacation - [name] shall have possession of the children in even-numbered years, beginning at [time] on the day the children are dismissed from school for the school's spring vacation and ending at [time] the children's school resumes after that vacation. [name] shall have possession of the children in odd-numbered years, beginning at [time] on the day the children are dismissed from school for the school's spring vacation and ending at [time] the children's school resumes after that vacation.

5. Child's Birthday - If a [parent/conservator] is not otherwise entitled under this order to present possession of a child on the child's birthday, the [parent/conservator] not in possession of the child shall have possession of the child*[and the child's minor siblings]* beginning at 6:00 p.m. and ending at 8:00 p.m. on that day, provided that the [parent/conservator] not in possession of the child picks up the child from the other [parent/conservator]'s residence and returns the child to that same place.

*[6. Father's Day Weekend - [name] shall have possession of the children for Father's Day, beginning at 6:00 p.m. on the Friday preceding Father's Day and ending at 6:00 p.m. on Father's Day, provided that if he is not otherwise entitled under this order to present possession of a child, he shall pick up that child from [name]'s residence and return the child to that same place.

]**[7. Mother's Day Weekend - [name] shall have possession of the children for Mother's Day, beginning at 6:00 p.m. on the Friday preceding Mother's Day and ending at 6:00 p.m. on Mother's Day, provided that if she is not otherwise entitled under this order to present possession of a child, she shall pick up that child from [name]'s residence and return the child to that same place.

]**[8. Extended Summer Possession -

In even-numbered years, [name] shall have possession of the children for thirty days _____. This period of possession shall begin and end at 6:00 p.m.

In even-numbered years, [name] shall have possession of the children for thirty days _____. This period of possession shall begin and end at 6:00 p.m.

In odd-numbered years, [name] shall have possession of the children for thirty days _____. This period of possession shall begin and end at 6:00 p.m.

In odd-numbered years, [name] shall have possession of the children for thirty days _____. This period of possession shall begin and end at 6:00

p.m.

9. Extended Summer Possession in Even-Numbered Years -

With Written Notice by [name] by April 1 - In even-numbered years, if [name] gives [name] written notice by April 1 of a year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the children for twenty-one days beginning no earlier than the day after the children's school is dismissed for the summer vacation and ending no later than twenty-eight days before school resumes at the end of the summer vacation in that year, to be exercised in no more than two separate periods of at least seven consecutive days each, as specified in the written notice*, provided that the period or periods of extended summer possession do not interfere with Father's Day Weekend*. These periods of possession shall begin and end at 6:00 p.m.

Without Written Notice by [name] by April 1 - In even-numbered years, if [name] does not give [name] written notice by April 1 of that year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the children for twenty-one consecutive days in that year beginning at 6:00 p.m. on June 22 and ending at 6:00 p.m. on July 13.

With Written Notice by [name] by May 1 - In even-numbered years, if [name] gives [name] written notice by May 1 of a year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the children for twenty-one days beginning no earlier than the day after the children's school is dismissed for the summer vacation and ending no later than seven days before school resumes at the end of the summer vacation in that year, to be exercised in no more than two separate periods of at least seven consecutive days each, as specified in the written notice, provided that the period or periods do not conflict with the period or periods of extended summer possession by [name] for that year* [or with Father's Day Weekend]*. These periods of possession shall begin and end at 6:00 p.m.

Without Written Notice by [name] by May 1 - In even-numbered years, if [name] does not give [name] written notice by May 1 of that year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the children for twenty-one consecutive days in that year beginning at 6:00 p.m. on July 13 and ending at 6:00 p.m. on August 3. If [name] has designated days within this twenty-one-day period as part of [name]'s period or periods of extended summer possession of the children, [name]'s extended period of summer possession shall begin at 6:00 p.m. on the last day designated by [name] and shall end at 6:00 p.m. twenty-one days later.

10. Extended Summer Possession in Odd-Numbered Years -

With Written Notice by [name] by April 1 - In odd-numbered years, if

[name] gives [name] written notice by April 1 of a year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the children for twenty-one days beginning no earlier than the day after the children's school is dismissed for the summer vacation and ending no later than twenty-eight days before school resumes at the end of the summer vacation in that year, to be exercised in no more than two separate periods of at least seven consecutive days each, as specified in the written notice*[, provided that the period or periods of extended summer possession do not interfere with Father's Day Weekend]*. These periods of possession shall begin and end at 6:00 p.m.

Without Written Notice by [name] by April 1 - In odd-numbered years, if [name] does not give [name] written notice by April 1 of that year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the children for twenty-one consecutive days in that year beginning at 6:00 p.m. on June 22 and ending at 6:00 p.m. on July 13.

With Written Notice by [name] by May 1 - In odd-numbered years, if [name] gives [name] written notice by May 1 of a year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the children for twenty-one days beginning no earlier than the day after the children's school is dismissed for the summer vacation and ending no later than seven days before school resumes at the end of the summer vacation in that year, to be exercised in no more than two separate periods of at least seven consecutive days each, as specified in the written notice, provided that the period or periods do not conflict with the period or periods of extended summer possession by [name] for that year*[, or with Father's Day Weekend]*. These periods of possession shall begin and end at 6:00 p.m.

Without Written Notice by [name] by May 1 - In odd-numbered years, if [name] does not give [name] written notice by May 1 of that year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, [name] shall have possession of the children for twenty-one consecutive days in that year beginning at 6:00 p.m. on July 13 and ending at 6:00 p.m. on August 3. If [name] has designated days within this twenty-one-day period as part of [name]'s period or periods of extended summer possession of the children, [name]'s extended period of summer possession shall begin at 6:00 p.m. on the last day designated by [name] and shall end at 6:00 p.m. twenty-one days later.

]*(d) General Terms and Conditions

Except as otherwise explicitly provided in this order, IT IS ORDERED[AND DECREED] that the terms and conditions of possession of the children are as follows:

1. Surrender of [names] by [name] - [name] is ORDERED to surrender [names] to [name] at the beginning of each period of [name]'s

possession at the residence of [name].*[If a period of possession by [name] begins at the time the child[ren]'s school is regularly dismissed, [name] is ORDERED to surrender [names] to [name] at the beginning of each such period of possession at the school in which the child[ren] [is/are] enrolled, and [name] is ORDERED to pick up [names] at the child[ren]'s school at the time the child[ren]'s school is regularly dismissed. If the child[ren] [is/are] not in school, [name] shall pick up the child[ren] at the residence of [name] at _____, and [name] is ORDERED to surrender [names] to [name] at the residence of [name] at _____ under these circumstances.]*

2. Surrender of [names] by [name] - [name] is ORDERED to surrender [names] to [name] at the beginning of each period of [name]'s possession at the residence of [name].*[If a period of possession by [name] begins at the time the child[ren]'s school is regularly dismissed, [name] is ORDERED to surrender [names] to [name] at the beginning of each such period of possession at the school in which the child[ren] [is/are] enrolled, and [name] is ORDERED to pick up [names] at the child[ren]'s school at the time the child[ren]'s school is regularly dismissed. 6. Surrender of [names] by [name] - [name] is ORDERED to surrender [names] to [name], if the child[ren] [is/are] in [name]'s possession or subject to [name]'s control, at the beginning of each period of [name]'s exclusive periods of possession, at the place designated in this order.

7. Return of [names] by [name] - [name] is ORDERED to return [names] to [name], if [name] is entitled to possession of [names], at the end of each of [name]'s exclusive periods of possession, at the place designated in this order.

8. Return of [names] by [name] - [name] is ORDERED to return [names] to [name], if [name] is entitled to possession of [names], at the end of each of [name]'s exclusive periods of possession, at the place designated in this order.

9. Personal Effects - Each [parent/conservator] is ORDERED to return with a child the personal effects that the child brought at the beginning of the period of possession.

10. Designation of Competent Adult - Each [parent/conservator] may designate any competent adult to pick up and return a child, as applicable. IT IS ORDERED that a [parent/conservator] or a designated competent adult be present when a child is picked up or returned.

11. Inability to Exercise Possession - Each [parent/conservator] is ORDERED to give notice to the other [parent/conservator] in possession of a child on each occasion that the [parent/conservator] will be unable to exercise that [parent/conservator]'s right of possession for any specified period. Repeated failure of a [parent/conservator] to give notice of an inability to exercise possessory rights may be considered as a factor in a modification of those possessory rights.

12. Written Notice - Written notice shall be deemed to have been timely made if received or postmarked before or at the time that notice is due.

*[13. Notice to School and Other [Parent/Conservator] - If a [parent/conservator]'s time of possession of a child ends at the time school resumes and for any reason the child is not or will not be returned to school, the [parent/conservator] in possession of the child is ORDERED to immediately notify the school and the other [parent/conservator] that the child will not be or has not been returned to school.
